
It was under the instructor's coaching that Pele became an ace football player. At the age of 18, Pele had become a very good player of football. He became a member of the Brazilian Football team. He participated in the world football competition and because of his skilful play, Brazilian became the world champion. Subsequently, he took part in the world football competition of 1962, 1966, 1970. In all, Pele scored 1216 goals in the 1254 matches played by him between 7th September 1956 to 2nd October 1974. This is a world record for a single soccer player.




OLYMPIC FLAME

The flame was ceremonially lighted for the first time at the Amsterdam Games in 1928. Its modern version was adopted in 1936 at the Berlin Games. It symbolizes the continuity between the Ancient and the Modern games.

OLYMPIC MOTTO

The Olympic motto is "Citius, Altius - Fortuis which means faster, higher and stronger. It was first adopted by Rev. Father Didan who was a great friend of Baron Pierre de Coubertin.

The games are now continued to play after every four years and was recently held in Athens.



The origin of the game of basket ball dates back to 1891. It is believed by some sports historians that a game called Pok - Tapok was played by ancient South Americans on the Yucatan Pennisula resembled the game of basket ball. The credit for starting this game and framing it's rules goes to James Naismith, a Canadian by birth.

he game was first practised on suspended peach basket and it was those baskets which gave the game its name.

The games of Basket Ball was first included in the Olympics in 1936 when the games were held in Berlin. In India this game was first played in 1930.

Basket ball is a popular game and is still considered to be a game of masses. Its popularity stems from the fact that it is a fast scoring game in which there is an intense activity from the beginning till the end.


