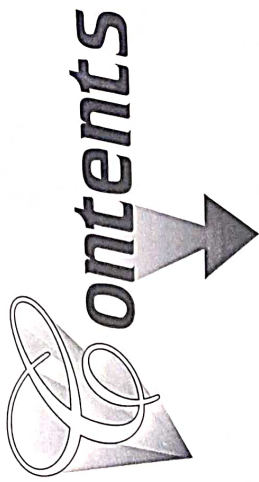

Memory is the treasury and guardian of all things. **CICERO**



VIGNESHI

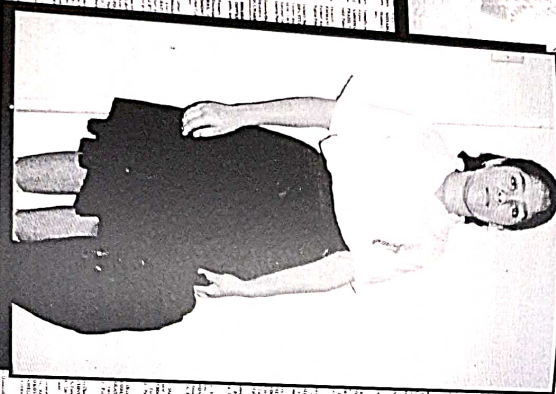
