### **2. HOUSE SYSTEM AND EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

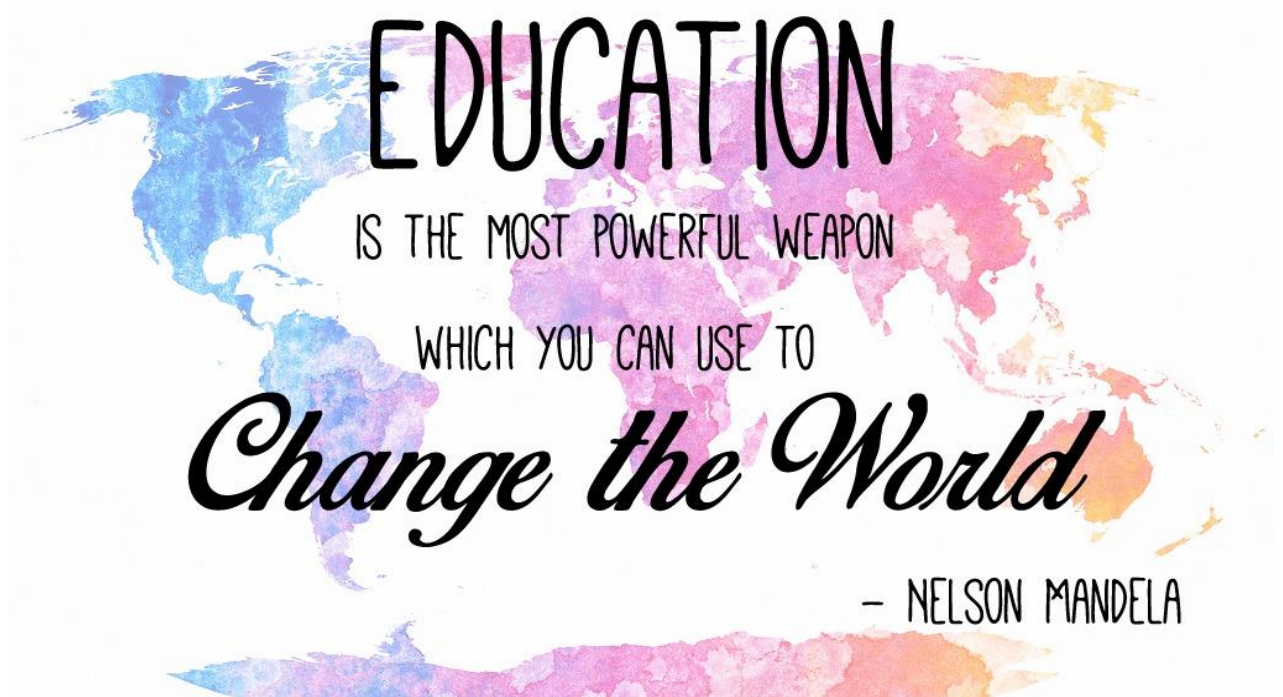
Students are divided into four Houses, namely Ganga, Yamuna, Krishna and Cauvery. Many Co-Curricular activities are organized for the holistic development of the child.
