## TEACHERS DAY

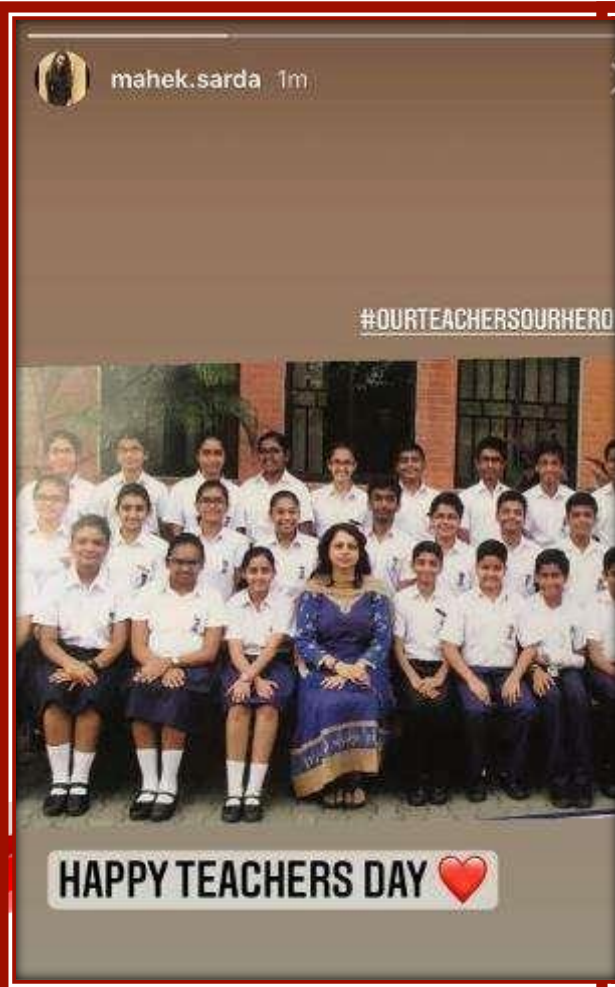

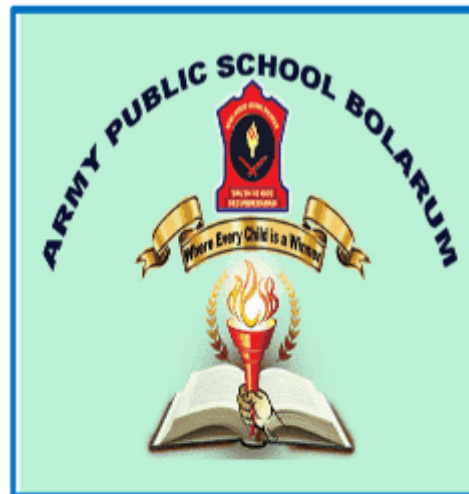
## CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY(CSR)
