- 7. That the Principal and Correspondent/Manager of the School have individually gone through the provisions contained in the affiliation & examination by elaws and the circulars issued by the Board from time to time.
- 8. The school undertakes to abide by the provisions contained in the affiliation & examination byelaws, directions issued from time to time and the law of the land.
- 9. That the school will ensure that the Building Safety, Fire Safety, Water Safety, Health and Hygiene certificates are being issued or renewed by the concerned municipal or state authorities from time to time as per the prescribed term.
- 10. That the school will ensure that sufficient number qualified teachers as per the provisions contained in affiliation bye-laws are available with the school before starting classes.

- 14. That the school will ensure that the school fulfils all essential requirement before applying for affiliation and will fulfil all other conditions post affiliation and comply with all the general rules as given in the affiliation byelaws or notified from time to time.
