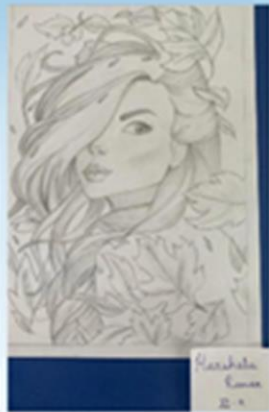
Best out of waste Competition 2020

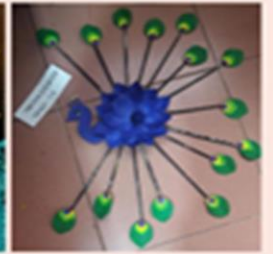

The pandemic times of the year 2020 was challenging and took a massive toll on humans across all age groups. On the 4th of December 2020, the training was conducted on the topic “Ethical Communication” by Annie Pink, a Corporate Trainer, an Internationally Certified NLP Life Coach and a NLP Practitioner. The training was attended by students of Grade 9, 10 , 11 and 12 and the Teachers from Grade 7 to Grade 12. The training was conducted via Zoom online.

The main modules of the training were –

1. Everyone has a unique model of the world
2. People are not their behaviours
3. Everyone is in charge of their mind and therefore the results.
4. Identify your internal and external resources.
5. There is no such thing as failure only feedback.
6. If you can do it, then I can empower myself to do the right thing.
7. The quality of our lives is determined by the quality of Communication.

The above modules were explained briefly with examples. The students asked questions during the Q&A session. The trainer concluded saying -

“You want a better life? Stop waiting for things to get better...start making things better...communicate to your-self ethically and thereby to others. Remember to respect and understand the fact that everyone has a unique model of their world “.
